Below you will find the instructions for making your bingo card. Please do your best to be precise when making your card as it too will be part of the game and you could end up with enough card blocks to make your own quilt! Anyone winning 40 or more strips will be eligible to participate in a STRIPPERS RACE on Sunday morning before we depart SEW... Get going ↓↔↑ and start sewing and getting STRIPPY SCRAP HAPPY!!! ☺ ☺ ☺

## GAME CARD INSTRUCTIONS

### Materials for 1 (10½") card

(Each fabric must be chosen from one of the following categories: batik, floral, geometric, heart, leaf, metallic, holiday, novelty, paisley, plaid, solid, star, stripe, or 1930s print. Use a black print for the center square.)

- 5 (2½") squares assorted yellow and orange prints
- 5 (2½") squares assorted red prints
- 5 (2½") squares assorted blue prints
- 5 (2½") squares assorted green prints
- 4 (2½") squares assorted pink and purple prints
- 1 (2½") square black print

### Block Assembly

1. Referring to photos of blocks, join 5 yellow/orange print squares to make 1 row. In the same manner,

make 1 red, 1 blue, and 1 green row.

2. Join 2 pink/purple squares. Make 2 pink/purple pairs. Join one pink/purple pair to each side of black square to complete pink/purple row.
3. Join rows, placing pink/purple row in center, to complete 1 Bingo Game Card block.
